INCREASING THE LEVEL OF ENTRAINED AIR IN THE MIXED MORTAR IMPROVES THE MOLECULAR ATTRACTION BY WHICH THE PARTICLES OF A BODY ARE UNITED THROUGHOUT THE MASS...

THE AIR BUBBLES ACT LIKE MINUTE BALL BEARINGS AND LUBRICATE THE MORTAR MAKING IT EASIER TO WORK.

THE EFFECTS ARE SO PRONOUNCED THAT MORTAR WITH INCREASED "ENTRAINED-AIR" IS REFERRED TO AS "ALIVE", WHEREAS THOSE NOT HAVING THE HIGHER LEVELS OF "ENTRAINED-AIR" ARE REFERRED TO AS "DEAD".

THE AIR BUBBLES ARE SO SMALL THAT THEY HAVE THE EFFECT OF IMPROVING THE OVERALL GRADING OF MOST FINE AGGREGATES.

THE ENTRAINED AIR BUBBLES WILL ALSO IMPROVE THE "FEEL" OF MORTARS PRODUCED FROM SANDS WHICH ARE NOT IDEAL OR ARE TOO COARSE.

ONCE THE MASON HAS AN OPPORTUNITY TO WORK WITH THE "**ALIVE**" MORTAR, HE WILL ALWAYS INSIST ON IT...
